

## The Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 2019

Made

10<sup>th</sup> October, 2019

Coming into operation

21<sup>st</sup> October, 2019

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963<sup>a</sup>, hereby orders:-

### Amendments to 1991 Order.

1. The Parking Places Order, 1991<sup>b</sup> is amended as follows.
2. In Part C of Schedule 1 –
  - (a) in the third column of the entry relating to disc parking place No. DC1, add at the end "but excluding Disc Parking Place No. DC1a",
  - (b) immediately after the entry relating to disc parking place No. DC1, insert –

"DC1a	La Vallette	The portion of the seaward side of the road immediately south of the entrance to the Mixed Bathing Pool, within limits indicated by signs as being reserved for persons in possession of a disabled person's badge."

- (c) in the entry relating to disc parking place No. DC43, delete "and Approved Parking Place No. AC32".

3. In Part E of Schedule 1 –

- (a) in the third column of the entry relating to disc parking place No. DE6, add at the end "and Disc Parking Places Nos. DE7 and DE7a",
- (b) immediately after the entry relating to disc parking place No. DE6, insert –

"DE7	South Esplanade	The southern portion of the east side of the road to the north of its junction with La Valette, as indicated by signs as being reserved for vehicles not exceeding 3.7m long by 2.1m wide.
DE7a	South Esplanade	The southern portion of the east side of the road to the north of its junction with La Valette, as indicated by signs as being reserved for vehicles not exceeding 3.7m long by 1.7m wide."

## 4. In Part A of Schedule 2 –

- (a) in the entry relating to approved parking place No. AA14, add at the end "within the limits indicated by signs as being reserved for vehicles not exceeding 3.6m long by 1.7m wide"
- (b) immediately after the entry relating to approved parking place No. AA37, insert –

"AA37a	Portelet, Torteval	The portion of the south side of the road within limits indicated by signs.
AA37b	Route de la Ligue, Torteval	The portion of the west side of the road within limits indicated by signs."

- (c) in the entry relating to approved parking place No. AA62, delete "but excluding approved parking place No. AC83",
- (d) in the entry relating to approved parking place No. AA69, for "AC40 and AC70" substitute "and AC40".

5. In Part C of Schedule 2, the entries relating to approved parking places Nos. AC32, AC70 and AC83 are deleted.

**Citation and commencement.**

6. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 3)

Order, 2019 and shall come into force on the 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Parking Places Order, 1991 so as to –

- (a) add an accessible parking space for blue badge holders at La Vallette and to return to 23-hour approved parking three such spaces which are no longer required at the estates at Valnord Hill, Les Genats and Courtil Portier,
- (b) create additional 23-hour approved parking at Portelet to the west of the Imperial Hotel and in the angled spaces of Route de la Lague,
- (c) introduce thirteen 10-hour small car disc parking spaces on the seaward side at the southern end of South Eplanade, replacing the standard size parking spaces opposite Havelet Waters in order to install an informal pedestrian crossing point,
- (d) replace a standard size approved parking space in Upper St Jacques with approved parking for a small car.

This Order comes into force on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2019.
