The Spirits etc. (Export to Alderney) Notification Ordinance, 1949

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration,
hereby order as follows: –

Spirits, Tobacco, Tea, etc.

NOTE

Section 1 was repealed by the European Communities (Food and Feed Controls) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2016, section 93, Schedule 12, with effect from 3rd October, 2019.

Lubricating Oils, Petrol, etc.

2. Article 2 of the Ordonnance relative à l'Exportation des Huiles Lubrifiantes, le Pétrole et Huiles Combustibles, l'Essence pour les Moteurs et l'Alcool Méthylique aux Îles de Sercq, d'Herm et de Jethou, of the 3rd day of December, 1932, shall have effect –

- (1) as though immediately after the words "hors de cette Île aux Îles" there were inserted the words "d'Auregny,", and
- (2) as though, in respect of export to Alderney, the words "en double" were omitted.

Matches.

3. A person shall not export or cause to be exported matches from this

Island to the Island of Alderney unless he shall previously have delivered to the [Chief Executive of the States of Guernsey] a notice in writing under his hand between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and four o'clock in the afternoon of the day preceding the day of export, stating in such notice the quantity of the matches in question, the proposed method of sending them, including therein the name of the ship in case of sending by sea, and the name and address of the consignee. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this section shall be an offence, punishable on conviction by a fine not exceeding [level 1 on the uniform scale].

NOTES

In section 3,

the words in the first pair of square brackets were substituted by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 3, with effect from 6th May, 2004, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 4 of the 2003 Ordinance;

the words in the second pair of square brackets were substituted by the Uniform Scale of Fines (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1989, section 2(2), with effect from 1st July, 1989.

The Ordinance was made and came into operation on 13th April, 1949.
