THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 40 and 109 of, and paragraphs 1(2) and 2 of Schedule 4 to, the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2017^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, following consultation with the Policy and Finance Committee of the States of Alderney, the Policy and Finance Committee of the Chief Pleas of Sark and the Data Protection Authority, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendments to the 2018 Regulations.

1. In regulations 2(2)(c)(ii), 6(4)(c)(ii) and 17(2)(b) of the Data Protection (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2018^b, for "2020" in each place where the expression occurs, substitute "2021".

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2019.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Data Protection (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2018 ("**the principal Regulations**").

Regulation 1 of these Regulations amends regulations 2 (registration fees), 6 (registered controllers and processors to pay annual levies) and 17 (transitional exemptions from registration) of the principal Regulations in relation to exemptions for controllers and processors that prior to the commencement of the Data Protection (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2017 ("**the Law**") would **not** have been required to be notified (registered) ("**previously exempt persons**").

Currently, those regulations exempt these previously exempt persons from the duty

to be registered under the Law as well as from the requirement to pay a registration fee (if registered) and the annual levy and late payment penalties. This exemption was to expire on the 1st January, 2020.

This amendment continues the exemption until the **1st January, 2021**.

Regulations 2 and 3 of these Regulations are the citation and commencement provisions respectively.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st January, 2020.
