**The Immigration (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment)  
Order, 2019**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 67A, 67B and 67C of the Immigration Act 2014 as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 2016<sup>a</sup> and section 33(1) of the Immigration Act 1971 as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1993<sup>b</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:-

**Amendment of the 2019 Order.**

1. In the Schedule to the Immigration (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2019<sup>c</sup>, for the table with the heading "Type of Application for Work Permit" in its second column, substitute the following table –

	<b>"Type of Application for Work Permit</b>	<b>Fee</b>
1.	First issue of a work permit valid for a period of one month or less.	£50
2.	First issue of a work permit valid for a period exceeding one month but not exceeding 9 months.	£100
3.	First issue of a work permit valid for a period exceeding 9 months but not exceeding 3 years.	£300
4.	First issue of a work permit valid for a period exceeding 3 years.	£500
5.	Issue of a work permit for change of employment where the work permit first issued was for a period exceeding 2 years.	£75
6.	Issue of a duplicate work permit in any case where the work permit is reported as lost, stolen or damaged.	£20
7.	Issue of a replacement work permit where necessary as a result of the employer providing incorrect information to the Committee.	£100".

**Interpretation.**

2. The Interpretation and Standard Provisions (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2016<sup>d</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order throughout the Bailiwick.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Immigration (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2019 ("the 2019 Order") to introduce two new categories of fees in respect of the issue of work permits under the Immigration Act 1971 as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1993.

The first fee category applies to the first issue of a work permit for a period of more

than one month but not more than 9 months. Previously, the fee for this category of work permits would have been £300, but this Order introduces the lower fee of £100 for this category.

The second fee category applies to the issue of a work permit for change of employment, where the work permit first issued was issued for a period of more than 2 years. This Order prescribes a fee of £75 for such 'change-of-employment' work permits.

This Order comes into force on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2019.
