

**The European Union (Exit Day and Designated Day)
(Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020**

Made 28th January, 2020

Coming into operation 28th January, 2020

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 11 and 12(1) of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Appointment of exit day and the designated day.

1. For the purposes of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018, 11pm on 31st December, 2020 is appointed as -

- (a) exit day, and
- (b) the designated day.

Revocation.

2. The European Union (Exit Day and Designated Day) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 3) Regulations, 2019^b are revoked.


Extent.

3. These Regulations have effect throughout the Bailiwick.

Citation and commencement.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the European Union (Exit Day and Designated Day) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 and come into force on the day they are made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

In anticipation of the coming into force of the the *Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community*, these Regulations appoint 11pm on 31st December, 2020 (being the planned end of the Transition Period) as both exit day and the designated day for the purposes of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018.

The effect of this is to defer key changes made by that Law, such as the repeal of the European Communities (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1973, the creation of Preserved EU law, the ending of the supremacy of EU law and related matters until the end of

the Transition Period.

These Regulations came into force on 28th January 2020, the day they were made.
