

## The Liquor Licensing (Fees) Regulations, 2020

*Made*

*9<sup>th</sup> March 2020*

*Coming into operation*

*1<sup>st</sup> June 2020*

*Laid before the States*

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 84(4) of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

### **Amendment of fees.**

1. The Fourth Schedule to the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006, is amended in accordance with the Schedule to these Regulations.

### **Interpretation.**

2. In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as in the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006.

### **Revocation.**

3. The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019<sup>b</sup> are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend Schedule 4 of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006 which sets the relevant fees for liquor licences etc. These Regulations come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020.
