



The Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) (La Vallette, St Peter Port) Order, 2020

Coming into operation

1 May 2020

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2(1) and (2) of the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007^a, as amended, hereby orders:-

1. In order to prevent nuisance or annoyance to members of the public or a section of the public or disorder which is likely to be associated with the consumption of intoxicating liquor in that place, the area in the Parish of St Peter Port outlined in red on the attached plan, that is:-

- (a) La Vallette road between the restaurant known as the "Octopus", Havelet and the entrance to the (old) Aquarium, including the foreshore, footpaths, bathing places, slipways and public seating areas situated on both sides of the road, and
- (b) the whole of the area known as the Clarence Battery, together with the steps leading between the roadway adjacent to the entrance to the (old) Aquarium and the Clarence Battery,

shall be a designated public place for the purpose of the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007 during the hours and days specified in article 2.

2. The area specified in article 1 shall be a designated public place between the hours 00:01 on 1st May, 2020 and 23:59 on 30th September 2020.

3. This Order may be cited as the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (La Vallette, St Peter Port) Order, 2020 and shall come into force on the 1st May, 2020.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order sets out the area of St Peter Port to be designated as a Designated Public Place under the provisions of Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007, between the hours 00:01 on 1st May, 2020 and 23:59 on 30th September, 2020.

This Order comes into force on the 1st day of May, 2020.

Explanatory Note
