

**The Parochial Elections (St Peter Port)
Regulations, 2020**

Coming into operation

18th March, 2020

THE STATES' ASSEMBLY & CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 54(4) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Elections to be held for the office of Douzenier in St Peter Port.

1. (1) An electors' meeting shall take place at the Harry Bound Room, Les Cotils, St Peter Port at 7.30pm on 8th April, 2020 to elect two Douzeniers in the Parish of St Peter Port.

(2) If a secret ballot is demanded at that meeting pursuant to the provisions of Article 59 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, the election shall be held at the Harry Bound Room, Les Cotils, St Peter Port at 7.30pm on 16th April, 2020.

Citation and commencement.


2. These Regulations may be cited as the Parochial Elections (St Peter Port) Regulations, 2020 and shall come into force on the day they are made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations provide for elections to the office of Douzenier to take place in the Parish of St Peter Port on 8th April, 2020, to fill a post left unfilled following elections held in November 2019. If a secret ballot is demanded at the elector's meeting to be held on 8th April, the Regulations provide for the contested election to take place on 16th April.

These Regulations came into force on the day they were made.
