**The Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey)
(Amendment) Regulations, 2020**

THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by 1, 3 and 4 of the Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Law, 1994^a, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014.

1. The Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014^b are amended as follows -

- (a) in regulation 2(1) -
 - (i) in subparagraph (b), for ".", substitute ", or", and

(ii) immediately after subparagraph (b), insert the following subparagraph -

"(c) any substance prepared or used for the purpose of disinfecting human skin.", and

(b) regulation 11(2) is revoked.

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 31st March 2020.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations repeal regulation 11(2) of the Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014, which limits the approval by the Committee for Employment and Social Security of any poisonous substance to pesticides which have

previously been approved under the UK Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986 or by the competent body of a Member State of the European Union (other than the UK). This repeal will accordingly permit the Committee to approve poisonous substances, including (but not limited to) pesticides, where it is appropriate to do so.

These Regulations will come into force on the 31st March, 2020.
