**The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2020**

**THE COMMITTEE for ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Fee payable by applicants for a boarding permit.**

1. An applicant for a boarding permit shall pay to the Committee on application for a permit valid from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021, or part thereof, a fee of £0.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise –

(a) “**the Law**” means the Tourist Law, 1948; and

(b) “**Committee**” means the Committee for Economic Development.

(2) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Revocation**

3. The Boarding Permit Fees Order (2), 2019<sup>b</sup> is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes and replaces the Boarding Permits Fees Order (2), 2019 which prescribed the fees payable by an applicant for a boarding permit for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021, by substituting a fee of £0 for all boarding permits for that period due to the exceptional circumstances arising from the Coronavirus pandemic. This Order comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020.
