**The Road Traffic (Construction and Use) (Exemptions)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 2020**

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 9E(2) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002^a, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Exemption to mirrors requirement.

1. (1) Motor cars first used before 1st June 1978 are exempt from section 9E(1) of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002 to the extent that the requirements in that subsection may be satisfied in respect of such a vehicle if it is equipped with one rear-view mirror, the dimensions and arrangement of which must, as far as practicable, enable the driver to see traffic to the rear of the vehicle.

(2) In this regulation –

“**first used**” means –

- (a) in the case of a vehicle which is registered, the date on which it was first registered, whether in Guernsey or elsewhere, or
- (b) in the case of a vehicle which is not registered, the date of manufacture,

"**motor car**" means a motor vehicle which –

- (a) is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of passengers and is not a goods vehicle,
- (b) has no more than eight seats in addition to the driver's seat,
- (c) has four or more wheels, and
- (d) has a maximum laden weight not exceeding 3,500 kilograms.



2. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Construction and Use) (Exemptions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2020.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 12th March, 2020.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations exempt from the requirement in section 9E of the Road Traffic (Construction and Use of Motor Vehicles) Ordinance, 2002 that all motor vehicles other than motorcycles must be equipped with two rear-view mirrors, motor cars (as defined) first used before 1st June 1978.

These Regulations will come into force on the 12th March, 2020.
