**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment)
Order, 2020**

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989^a, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. (1) Part I of Schedule 1 of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989 is amended as follows.

(2) In entry number 21, for the words from "This paragraph" to the end, substitute "This paragraph does not apply between the hours of 5 a.m. and 10 a.m., for the purpose of loading or unloading".

(3) After entry number 24, insert –

"25. Rue à l'Or: This paragraph only applies to the section between Richmond Avenue and Le Vauquiedor, except for access to premises therein and cycles."

Repeal.

2. The Traffic Temporary (North Plantation and Rue à L'Or) Regulations, 2019^b are repealed.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2020.

Commencement

4. This Order shall come into force on the 28th April, 2020.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The purpose of this Order is to amend the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989 by making permanent the traffic experiments –

(a) in relation to the prohibited street at North Plantation, to permit access only for the purpose of loading and unloading between the hours of 5 a.m. and 10 a.m. (access for other purposes will be allowed by permit only), and

(b) to prohibit access to the section of Rue à l'Or between Richmond Avenue and Le Vauquiedor, except for access to premises and for cycles.

This Order will come into force on the 28th April, 2020.
