**The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical  
Benefit) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2020**

**THE COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT & SOCIAL SECURITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990<sup>a</sup> and section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004<sup>b</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Amendment to the 2004 Regulations.**

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004<sup>c</sup> ("**the Schedule**") -

- (b) substitute the entry relating to Factor VIII fraction in the row of the Schedule referred to in columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 to these Regulations for the appropriate entry set out in column 3 of Schedule 2 to these Regulations.

**Citation, commencement and extent.**

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2020, and shall come into force on the 30th day of April, 2020.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

5.3	Antivirals	Maraviroc 25mg, 75mg, 150mg, 300mg tablets, 20mg /ml oral solution ( For second line use and Consultant initiation only)
8.1	Cytotoxic drugs	Niraparib 100mg capsules (according to NICE TA 528 or any revision thereof)
4.7	Analgesics	Oxycodone hydrochloride 10mg per 1 ml, 50mg per 1 ml solution for injection (for Palliative Care prescribing only)

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations add three drugs to the list of drugs that may be prescribed as pharmaceutical benefit and limit the permissible dispensing of a drug already on that list to the Princess Elizabeth Hospital Pharmacy.

These Regulations come into force on the 30th April, 2020.
