

The Water Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 2020

THE STATES' TRADING SUPERVISORY BOARD, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Loi ayant rapport a la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile, 1927, as amended^a, sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

Amendments to water charges for 2020.

1. For paragraphs 1, 2 and 4 of the Schedule to the Water Charges Ordinance 1991^c, as amended, substitute the following paragraphs –

"1. The charges which may be made under section 5 for a supply of water to a property by measure are –

- (a) a charge of £1.01 per cubic metre of water supplied, and
- (b) the quarterly charge in column 2 below appearing opposite the size shown in column 1 of the meter which measures the property's supply.

1. Size of meter	2. Quarterly charge
15 mm (½")	£14.42
20 mm (¾")	£28.84
25 mm (1")	£33.55
40 mm (1½")	£39.63
50 mm (2")	£42.79
75 mm (3")	£45.72
100 mm (4")	£51.77

2. The charge which may be made under section 4 or 6 for a supply of water for domestic purposes to a property otherwise than by measure is the quarterly charge in column 2 below and a quarterly charge of £0.28 multiplied by each assessable unit of the property as calculated for the purposes of property tax under the provisions of the Taxation of Real Property (Guernsey and Alderney) Ordinance, 2007^d.

1. Rate per assessable unit of TRP	2. Quarterly charge
£0.28	£14.42

4. (a) £67.97 (where the Board considers that the shutting-off or subsequent reconnection of the supply in question by the Board's employee has caused that employee to undertake duties outside his normal working hours).
- (b) £43.04 (in any other case).

Revocation.

2. The Water Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 2018^e and The Water Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 2019^f are revoked

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 2020.


Commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prescribe the charges which will be made for the supply of water for 2021. These Regulations come into force on 1st January, 2021.
