**The Boarding Permit Fees (No. 2) Order, 2020**

THE COMMITTEE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Fee payable by applicants for a boarding permit.**

1. An applicant for a boarding permit shall pay to the Committee for Economic Development on application for a permit valid from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022, or part thereof, a fee of £0.

**Revocation.**

2. The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2020<sup>b</sup> is revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order prescribes the fees payable by an applicant for a boarding permit valid during the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022. The fee will continue to be £0 for all boarding permits for that period due to the ongoing exceptional circumstances arising from the Coronavirus pandemic.

This Order comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2021.
