THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^a and section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2004 Regulations.



Citation, commencement and extent.

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No.4) Regulations, 2020, and shall come into force on the 17th day of November, 2020.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations add a number of drugs and medical appliances to the list of drugs and medical appliances that may be prescribed as pharmaceutical benefit. Following the coming into force of the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2020, it is now the function of the Committee for Health & Social Care to make regulations amending the list of drugs that may be prescribed as pharmaceutical benefit.

These Regulations come into force on the 17th November, 2020.
