



## The Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2020

*Made*

31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020

*Coming into operation*

*See Article 3*

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946<sup>a</sup> and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

### Amendments to Export Order.

1. (1) The Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2010<sup>b</sup> is amended as follows.

(2) In Schedule 4, after paragraph 3 insert –

"4. Any animals or goods (within the meaning of Article 3 of Preserved Regulation (EU) 2017/625) originating outside the British Islands (except where exported under the authority, and in accordance with the conditions of an export permit, export licence or similar authority issued by the appropriate Designated

Authority within the meaning of section 1 of the European Communities (Official Controls) (Implementation and General Provisions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2019).",

and after paragraph 6 insert –

"7. "Dangerous products within the meaning of the General Product Safety Regulations (U. K. S. I. 2005/1803).

**Interpretation.**

In this Schedule, ""Preserved Regulation (EU) 2017/625" means Regulation (EU) 2017/625 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 March 2017 on official controls and other official activities performed to ensure the application of food and feed law, rules on animal health and welfare, plant health and plant protection products, amending Regulations (EC) No 999/2001, (EC) No 396/2005, (EC) No 1069/2009, (EC) No 1107/2009, (EU) No 1151/2012, (EU) No 652/2014, (EU) 2016/429 and (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament and of the Council, Council Regulations (EC) No 1/2005 and (EC) No 1099/2009 and Council Directives 98/58/EC, 1999/74/EC, 2007/43/EC, 2008/119/EC and 2008/120/EC, and repealing Regulations (EC) No 854/2004 and (EC) No 882/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council, Council Directives 89/608/EEC, 89/662/EEC, 90/425/EEC, 91/496/EEC, 96/23/EC, 96/93/EC and 97/78/EC and Council Decision 92/438/EEC (Official Controls Regulation), as it forms part of Preserved EU law.".

**Citation.**

2. This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 2020.

**Commencement.**

3. This Order comes into force on exit day; and for this purpose "exit day" has the meaning given by section 12(1) of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law,
