

**The European Union (Competition) (Brexit)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 2021**

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1) and 11 of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and upon receipt of the certificate required under section 5(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Competition Ordinance.

1. In section 54 of the Competition (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2012^b, for "must", substitute "may".

Extent.

2. These Regulations take effect in the islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.


Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations shall be cited as the European Union (Competition) (Brexit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2021 and come into force on the day on which they are made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made under the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018, as a consequence of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the EU. The Regulations amend section 54 of the Competition (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2012 so that when determining questions arising in relation to competition law, the taking into account of EU principles and decisions by the Guernsey Competition and Regulatory Authority and Royal Court, is discretionary rather than mandatory.
