# **The Bar (Examination Fee) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021**

**THE ROYAL COURT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007<sup>1</sup>, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

## **Amendment of the Bar (Examination Fee) Regulations, 2011.**

1. (1) The Bar (Examination Fee) Regulations, 2011<sup>2</sup> are amended as follows.
  - (2) In Regulation 1(a), for "£1,000" substitute "£1,200".
  - (3) In Regulation 1(b), for "£200" substitute "£300".

## **Amendment of the Bar Ordinance, 1949.**

2. (1) Section 5 of the Bar Ordinance, 1949<sup>3</sup> is amended as follows.
  - (2) For "£1,000" substitute "£1,200", and for "£200" substitute "£300".

## **Citation.**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Bar (Examination Fee) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.
