**The European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit)
(Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2021**

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1) and 11 of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a, and upon receipt of the certificate required under section 5(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Law.

1. (1) The Sea Fish Licensing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012 is amended as follows.

(2) In section 5C -

(a) for subsection (6)(c), substitute -

^a Order in Council No. I of 2019.

"(c) subject to subsection (8), shall only be valid for four months after exit day.",

(b) in subsection (8), for "a further period of three months", substitute "further successive periods not exceeding one month", and

(c) in subsection (13)(a), for "for the purposes of subsection (10)(a)", substitute "under subsection (11)(a)".

Amendment of the principal Regulations.

2. In regulation 12(1) of the European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020, for "April" substitute "July".


Extent.

3. These Regulations have effect throughout the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the territorial waters adjacent thereto.

Citation and commencement.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2021 and shall come into force at 11pm on 31st March 2021.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in consequence of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union.

The European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 ("the principal Regulations") amended the Sea Fish Licensing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012 ("the 2012 Law") on the basis of the access for French fishing boats agreed as part of the Trade and Cooperation Agreement between the United Kingdom and the European Union to permit those fishing boats to fish under temporary authorisations.

These Regulations further amend the 2012 Law to extend the period of validity of temporary authorisations made under Part IA to a period of four months from exit day (11pm on 31st December 2020). The power of the Committee for Economic Development to renew temporary authorisations has also been amended to allow the Committee to extend their validity for further periods not exceeding one month.

The principal Regulations also modified and extended the Police Force (Guernsey) Law, 1986 ("the 1986 Law") to permit officers of a UK police force or the States of Jersey Police Force to exercise the powers of a Guernsey police officer across the Bailiwick (including their territorial waters). These Regulations amend the principal Regulations to continue the modification and extension of the 1986 Law until 1st July 2021.

These Regulations will come into force at 11pm on 31st March 2021.
