



The Parochial Elections (St Saviour) Regulations, 2021

THE STATES' ASSEMBLY & CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 54(4) and 77C of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Election to be held for the office of Douzenier in St Saviour.

1. An electors' meeting shall take place at St Saviour's Community Centre, Le Neuf Chemin, St Saviour on 26 April, 2021, immediately after the conclusion of the meeting called by the St Saviour's Church Property Management Board at 7pm, to elect Susan Mary Watson to the office of Douzenier in the Parish of St Saviour.
