THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14B and 79 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2020 Regulations.

1. In regulation 26(2) of the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^b, for "1st July 2021" substitute "1st January 2022".

Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021, and shall come

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 to delay their coming into force from 1st July 2021 to 1st January 2022. This change has been made to assist businesses and aligns with the commencement of the equivalent United Kingdom provisions under a new timetable for introducing import border control processes after Brexit.

These Regulations came into force on being made.
