THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^a and section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2004 Regulations.



Citation, commencement and extent.

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No.4) Regulations, 2021, and shall come into force on the 16th day of June, 2021.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

8.1.5	Other neoplastic drugs	Panobinostat hard capsules 10mg, 15mg, 20mg (in accordance with NICE TA number 380 or any revision thereof only)
8.1.5	Other neoplastic drugs	Ponatinib, film-coated tablets 15mg, 30mg, 45mg (in accordance with NICE TA number 451 or any revision thereof only)
8.1.5	Other neoplastic drugs	Ribociclib, film-coated tablets, 200mg. (in accordance with NICE TA number 496 or any revision thereof only)
8.1.5	Other neoplastic drugs	Ceritinib, film-coated tablets, 150mg (in accordance with NICE TA number 500 or any revision thereof only)
