

Ordinance regarding Itinerant Hawkers (Sark), 1939

Michaelmas Meeting of the Chief Pleas held on the 8th November, 1939

Itinerant Hawkers, any person who goes from place to place or to private houses carrying or causing to be carried goods which he sells or offers or exposes for sale must apply to the Constable who will make an application to the Court for a licence which shall be £5 sterling for a term of six months, this will not apply to bona fide travellers. A hawker shall not be permitted to hawk goods other than that specified in his licence under a penalty of a fine at the deliberation of the Court.
