**The Immigration (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)
(Amendment) Order, 2022**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 67A, 67B and 67C of the Immigration Act 2014^a as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 2016^b, section 33(1) of the Immigration Act 1971^c as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1993^d, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the 2019 Order.

1. (1) The Schedule to the Immigration (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2019^e is amended as follows.

(2) In the table headed "*Applications for Sector Based Scheme Work Permits*", immediately after item no. 2, insert the following item –

"2A.	Subsequent issue of Sector Based Scheme work permit for a period exceeding one month but not exceeding 12 months	£100".

(3) In the table headed "*Applications for Leave to Remain, other than a Work Permit (first issue) or Appendix EU Leave*" –

(a) in the table heading, delete "*a Work Permit (first issue) or*",

(b) immediately after item no. 1, insert the following item –

"1A.	Leave to remain for a limited period exceeding one month but not exceeding 12 months, where the application is made solely in conjunction with the issue of a subsequent Sector Based Scheme work permit	£244".

(c) in item no. 2, immediately after "period", insert ", not falling within item 1A,", and

(d) in item no. 5, immediately after "items", insert "1A,".


Citation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Immigration (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2019 to prescribe a fee for the subsequent issue of a Sector Based Scheme work permit for a period exceeding one month but not exceeding 12 months, as well as leave to remain for that period granted to the permit holder.

This Order will come into force on the 19th January, 2022.
