**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)
(Russian Aircraft) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)
Regulations, 2022**

THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35(1)(c) of the Air Navigation (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012^a and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Restriction of flying in Bailiwick airspace for Russian aircraft.

1. (1) Subject to paragraph (3), no Russian aircraft shall fly in Bailiwick of Guernsey airspace, including in the airspace above the Bailiwick's territorial sea.

(2) For the purposes of this regulation a "**Russian aircraft**" is an aircraft which is owned, chartered or operated by a person connected with Russia, or which is registered in Russia

(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with the permission of—

- (a) the Acting Director of Civil Aviation,
- (b) the UK Secretary of State for the Department for

Transport, or

(c) air traffic control in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Russian Aircraft) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2022 and shall come into force on 28th February, 2022.
