THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14D and 79 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2020 Regulations.

1. In regulation 26(4) of the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^b, for "1st July 2022" substitute "31st December 2023".

Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022, and shall come into force on being made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 to further delay the commencement of Part I (Imports) from 1st July 2022 to 31st December 2023. This change has been made to align with the planned commencement of the equivalent United Kingdom provisions.

These Regulations came into force on being made.
