THE WASTE DISPOSAL AUTHORITY^a, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 32(3)(c) and (4) and section 72 of the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the 2021 Regulations.

1. (1) The Waste Disposal and Recovery Charges Regulations, 2021^c are amended as follows.

(2) In the third column of Category C of Table 1 of Schedule 1 (Longue Hougue Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC)), for each reference to "£2.70" substitute "£2.92".

Citation and commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the charges, payable from 1st July 2022, for bags of household waste delivered to the Longue Hougue Household Waste Recycling Centre by a private individual. The charges are amended to be consistent with the equivalent charge payable from 1st July, 2022 for 90 litre bags of residual household waste put out for collection by the kerbside collection service.

These Regulations come into force on 1st July, 2022.
