**The Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Bailiwick
of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 7(3) and (3A), 15, 34, 39, 75 and 132 of the Medicines (Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008^a, section 15(3) of the Prescription Only Medicines (Human) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2009^b (following consultation with the Policy & Resources Committee of the States of Guernsey, the Policy and Finance Committee of the States of Alderney and the Medical & Emergency Services Committee of the Chief Pleas) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the 2020 Regulations.

1. The Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^c ("**the principal Regulations**") are amended as set out in regulations 2 and 3.

2. Regulation 1 of the principal Regulations is revoked.

3. In regulation 7 of the principal Regulations, for the definition of "**designated vaccine**", substitute the following definition –

""**designated vaccine**" has the meaning given by section 15(3) of the Prescription Only Medicines (Human) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2009,".

Amendment of the Medicines (Human) (Advertising) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2009.

4. Regulation 36(1) of the Medicines (Human) (Advertising) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2009^d is amended by substituting, for the definition of "**designated vaccine**", the following definition –

""**designated vaccine**" has the meaning given by section 15(3) of the Prescription Only Medicines (Human) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2009,".

Revocations.

5. The following regulations are revoked –
- (a) regulation 2 of the Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2021^e,
 - (b) the Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Amendment No. 2) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2021^f, and
 - (c) the Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Amendment No. 3) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2021^g, and
 - (d) the Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Amendment No. 4) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2021^h.

Citation.

6. These Regulations may be cited as the Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2022.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Medicines (Coronavirus and Influenza) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 ("**the principal Regulations**") to revoke the designation of the COVID-19 Vaccine AstraZeneca (for use for vaccination or immunisation against the coronavirus). No vaccine will remain designated for the time being, after these Regulations come into force.

Regulations 1 to 3 of these Regulations revoke regulation 1 of the principal Regulations and replace the definition of "designated vaccine" with a generic definition referring to any vaccine that *may* be designated (in the future) as a designated vaccine under section 15 of the Prescription Only Medicines (Human) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2009.

Regulation 4 of these Regulations amend the Medicines (Human) (Advertising) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2009 to substitute the definition of "designated vaccine" in those regulations with the same generic definition.

Regulation 5 of these Regulations revoke previous Regulations that substituted or amended regulation 1 of the principal Regulations.

These Regulations will come into force on 14th June 2022.
