THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 5 of the Forfeiture of Money, etc. in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022^a, section 20 of the Interpretation and Standard Provisions (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2016^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations: -

Commencement of the 2022 Ordinance.

1. (1) The Civil Forfeiture (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2022 shall come into force on 31st January, 2023.

Amendment of 2007 Law.

2. Section 61(3) of the Forfeiture of Money, etc in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2007^c is repealed.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Forfeiture of Money in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022 (Commencement etc.) Regulations, 2022, and shall come into force on 21st December, 2022.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
