**The Public Holidays (Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III)  
Regulations, 2022**

**THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1A(1) of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1994<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, makes the following regulations:-

**Public holiday to mark the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III.**

1. (1) In 2023, the 8<sup>th</sup> May is appointed as an additional public holiday.
- (2) Section 1 of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1994 is varied accordingly.

**Citation.**

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Holidays (Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III) Regulations, 2022.
