THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 54 of, and paragraph 2(6) of Schedule 5 to, the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1999^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Law.

1. Schedule 5 to the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1999 is amended as follows -

(a) in paragraph 2(3)(b) for "£720" substitute "£780",

(b) in paragraph 2(3)(b)(i) -

(i) for "£110" substitute "£120",

(ii) for "£549" substitute "£590", and

(c) in paragraph 2(3)(b)(ii) for "£2,915" substitute "£3,150".

Revocation.

2. The Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021^b are revoked.


Citation.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st January 2023.
