THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 108 of Preserved Regulation (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament and of the Council on protective measures against pests of plants^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the 2020 Regulations.

1. (1) The Plant Health (Brexit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^b are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 6(1) (transitional provision: plants, plant products and other objects from EU Member states), for each reference to "31st December, 2022" substitute "30th June, 2023".



Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Health (Amendment of Transitional Provision) (Guernsey) (No. 2) Regulations, 2022 and shall come into force on the 31st December, 2022.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the transitional provision in regulation 6 of the Plant Health (Brexit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2020, which makes transitional provision in relation to phytosanitary certificates to accompany certain plants and plant products imported into Guernsey from EU Member States. The provision extends the transitional provision relating to plants etc. from the EU to 30th June, 2023. This is consistent with proposals to extend the equivalent transitional provision in Great Britain.

These Regulations come into force on the 31st day of December, 2022.
