**The European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023**

THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1) and 11 of the European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018^a, and upon receipt of the certificate required under section 5(3) of that Law, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Law.

1. The Sea Fish Licensing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012^b ("**the Law**") is amended as set out below.

2. In section 5HA(6)(d), for the words "until such date specified" to the end of the paragraph substitute "for a maximum of two years from the date specified in the licence."

Extent.

3. These Regulations have effect throughout the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the territorial waters adjacent thereto.


Citation.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023.

Commencement.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on 24th January, 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in consequence of the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union.

These Regulations amend the Sea Fish Licensing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012 to permit licences granted to EU fishing vessels to have effect for a period of not more than 2 years from the date stated in the licence itself, rather than from the date on which the licence was granted.

These Regulations will come into force on 24th January 2023.
