The Public Holidays (Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2022

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 11th January 2023 and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of, and paragraph (o) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 2004^a, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Public holiday to mark the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III.

1. Without prejudice to the provisions of the Public Holidays (Alderney) Ordinance, 1988^b, 8th May 2023 shall be a public holiday.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays (Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2023.
