Highways (Co-ordination of Temporary Road Closures etc.) (Guernsey) Law, 2003^a
and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby order:-

Amendment of Order.

1. The Public Highways (Temporary Road Closures) (Fees and Penalties)
Order, 2016^b is amended as follows.
2. In Article 1(2)(a), for "£103", substitute "£110".
3. In Article 2(1)(a), for "£103", substitute "£110".
4. In Schedule 1, in the table, in the row relating to "Inter-Harbour Route"



- (a) in the column headed "0 – 5 years", for "£90", substitute "£92", and
- (b) in the column headed "11 or more years (or has never previously been resurfaced)", for "£32", substitute "£33".

Citation and commencement.

5. This Order may be cited as the Public Highways (Temporary Road Closures) (Fees and Penalties) (Amendment) Order, 2023 and shall come into force on the 1st April 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Public Highways (Temporary Road Closures) (Fees and Penalties) Order, 2016 to increase the fees payable to the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure in respect of applications under the Public Highways (Co-ordination of Temporary Road Closures etc.) (Guernsey) Law, 2003 for permission for the temporary closure of a road or pavement, or the application of traffic management measures in a road, when the relevant work will involve the resurfacing of the road or pavement. It also increases the penalty fee payable where a person granted permission for such an application fails to comply with conditions attached to the permission.

The Order comes into force on the 1st day of April, 2023.
