THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 84(4) of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Amendment of fees.

1. The Fourth Schedule to the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006, is amended in accordance with the Schedule to these Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as in the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006.

Revocation.

3. The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022^b are hereby revoked.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Fees) Regulations, 2023 and shall come into force on the 1st June, 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend Schedule 4 of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006 which sets the relevant fees for liquor licences etc. These Regulations come into force on 1st June 2023.
