THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8 of the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 2023^a, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Commencement of Ordinance.

1. (1) Subject to paragraph 2, the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 2023 ("**the Ordinance**") shall come into force on 20th October, 2023.

(2) Section 4 of the Ordinance shall not come into force to the extent that the Schedule 8 inserted into the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime)

(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1999^b by section 4 applies to persons undertaking non-local legal services (within the meaning of the inserted Schedule 8) primarily from or within a jurisdiction outside the Bailiwick, and consequently paragraph 25 (specified jurisdictions) of the inserted Schedule 8 shall not come into force.

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 2023 (Commencement) Regulations, 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations bring into force the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 2023 ("**the Ordinance**") for most purposes on 20th October, 2023. The Ordinance is not brought into force to the extent that the Schedule 8 inserted into the Criminal Justice (Proceeds of Crime) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1999 by section 4 of the Ordinance applies to persons

undertaking non-local legal services (within the meaning of the inserted Schedule 8) primarily from or within a jurisdiction outside the Bailiwick; and, as a consequence, these Regulations do not bring into force paragraph 25 (specified jurisdictions) of the inserted Schedule 8.
