**The Parochial Elections (School Committee and  
Procureur) (St Peter Port) Regulations, 2023**

THE STATES' ASSEMBLY & CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 54(4), 61A and 77C of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>a</sup>, section 3 of the Education (School Committees) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970<sup>b</sup>, article XVII of the Public Assistance Law, 1937<sup>c</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Elections to be held for the office of Constable and Douzenier in St Peter Port, to various Schools' Committees and to the office of Procureur of the Poor.**

1. (1) An electors' meeting shall take place at the Harry Bound Room, Les Cotils, St Peter Port on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 to elect –

(a) one Constable in the Parish of St Peter Port,

(b) eight Douzeniers in the Parish of St Peter Port,

- (c) one member of the Amhurst and Vauvert Infants and Junior Schools' Committee,
- (d) one member of the La Mare de Carteret High School Committee, and
- (e) one Procureur of the Poor in the Parish of St Peter Port.

(2) If a secret ballot is demanded at that meeting pursuant to the provisions of Article 59 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, the election shall be held at the Harry Bound Room, Les Cotils, St Peter Port on 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.

**Citation and commencement.**

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Parochial Elections (School Committee and Procureur) (St Peter Port) Regulations, 2023 and shall come into force on the day they are made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations provide for elections to the office of Constable and to the office of Douzenier to take place in the Parish of St Peter Port on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2023, to elect

one Constable and eight Douzeniers, for a full term or to serve for an unexpired term. The Regulations also provide for the election of members of the Amhurst and Vauvert Infants and Junior Schools' Committee, La Mare de Carteret High School Committee and Baubigny Schools Committee. The Regulations additionally provide for the election of a Procureur of the Poor. If a secret ballot is demanded at the electors' meeting to be held on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 the Regulations provide for the contested election to take place on 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.

These Regulations came into force on being made.
