**The Customs and Excise (Safety and Security)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023**

Made 13th November, 2023

Coming into operation 19th December, 2023

Laid before the States , 2023

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14D and 79 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the 2020 Regulations.

1. (1) The Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^b are amended as follows.

(2) In Regulation 26(4), for "31st December 2023" substitute "31st October 2024".

(3) In paragraph 2 of Part 2 of the Schedule (Exempt Goods), at the end of subparagraph (d) delete "and", at the end of subparagraph (e) for "." substitute "; and", and after subparagraph (e) insert -

"(f) where the goods are sea fish –

(i) taken by a fishing boat (regardless of the country or territory of registration) in Bailiwick fishery limits in accordance with a licence or other authorisation under the Sea Fish Licensing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012, and

(ii) to be landed directly into a country or territory outside of the Customs Territory,

and for the purposes of this subparagraph, "**Bailiwick fishery limits**", "**fishing boat**" and "**sea fish**" have the meaning given in the Sea Fish Licensing (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012."

Revocation of the 2022 Amendment Regulations.

2. The Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022^c are revoked.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Safety and

Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023, and shall come into force on 19th December, 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 ("the 2020 Regulations") to further delay the commencement of Part I (Imports) from 31st December 2023 to 31st October 2024. This change has been made to align with the planned commencement of the equivalent United Kingdom provisions.

The Schedule to the 2020 Regulations is also amended to remove the requirement to submit an Exit Summary Declaration (EXS) for sea fish taken by a fishing boat in Bailiwick fishery limits which is to be landed directly into a country or territory outside of the Customs Territory.

These Regulations come into force on 19th December, 2023.
