

**Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013
(Amendment) Regulations, 2023**

Made 16th November, 2023

Coming into operation 17th November, 2023

Laid before the States , 2023

THE COMMITTEE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 111 and 113 of the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the LLP Law.

1. (1) The Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013 is amended as follows.

(2) After subsection (4C) of section 8 (incorporation of an LLP), insert –

"(4D) An LLP that does not have a registered office situate in Guernsey shall be guilty of an offence."

(3) For subsection (6) of section 8, substitute –

"(6) On receiving the incorporation statement, particulars of the governance provisions of the members' agreement and prescribed fee, and being satisfied that the incorporation statement and particulars of the governance provisions of the members' agreement comply with the provisions of this section, the Registrar shall, subject to the provisions of this Law, register the LLP, issue a certificate of incorporation in such form as the Registrar may determine, and allocate a registration number to the LLP."

(4) In subsection (1) of section 9 (change in registered particulars) –

(a) at the end of paragraph (a), insert "or", and

(b) delete paragraphs (b) and (c).

(5) In the definition of "corporate services provider" at subsection (1) of section 114 (interpretation), after "primary" insert "or secondary".

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013 (Amendment) Regulations, 2023.

Commencement.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on 17th November, 2023.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make amendments to the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013 ("the Law") relating to the process of registering limited liability partnerships, failure to have a registered office in Guernsey and an administrative requirement on limited liability partnerships to give notice to the Registrar of certain changes. The regulations also make a technical amendment to the definition of the term "corporate services provider". The purpose of the amendments is to promote consistency in enactments relating to legal persons, and to remove unnecessary duplication. They came into force on 17th November, 2023.
