

The Parochial Elections (St Martin)
(No. 2) Regulations, 2023

THE STATES' ASSEMBLY & CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by articles 54(4) and 77C of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Elections to be held for the office of Douzenier in St Martin.

1. (1) An electors' meeting shall take place at the Parish Hall, La Grande Rue, St Martin GY4 6LQ on 29th November, 2023 to elect four Douzeniers in the Parish of St Martin.

(2) If a secret ballot is demanded at that meeting pursuant to the provisions of article 59 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, the election shall be held at the Parish Hall, La Grande Rue, St Martin GY4 6LQ on 13th December, 2023.

Revocation.

2. The Parochial Elections (St Martin) Regulations, 2023^b are revoked.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Parochial Elections (St Martin) (No. 2) Regulations, 2023 and shall come into force on the day they are made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations provide for elections to the office of Douzenier to take place in the Parish of St Martin on 29th November, 2023, in relation to three expired vacancies and one unexpired vacancy to 31st December 2024. If a secret ballot is demanded at the elector's meeting to be held on 29th November, the Regulations provide for the contested election to take place on 13th December. The Regulations also revoke a previous set of regulations which provided for an electors' meeting to be held on 22nd November, because that electors' meeting did not take place. These Regulations came into force on the day they were made.
