THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 6 of the Criminal Justice (Miscellaneous Amendments – Preventative Offences) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2023^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations: -

Coming into force of section 2(3) of the 2023 Ordinance.

1. Section 2(3) of the Criminal Justice (Miscellaneous Amendments – Preventative Offences) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2023 (which provision amends the definition of "terrorist financing" in section 79(1) of the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002^b) is brought into force.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Miscellaneous Amendments – Preventative Offences) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 2023 (Commencement) Regulations, 2023, and shall come into force on being made.
