(AMENDMENT) RULES, 2023**

The Capacity (Lasting Powers of Attorney) (Appeals, etc.) (Amendment) Rules, 2023

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 83 of the Capacity (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2020^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to Rules.

1. (1) The Capacity (Lasting Powers of Attorney) (Appeals, etc.) Rules, 2022^b are amended as follows.

(2) In rule 7 -

(a) in paragraph (1)(a) -

(i) in item (i), for "£80" substitute "£88",

(ii) in item (ii), for "£100" substitute "£110",

(b) in paragraph 1(b), for "£30" substitute "£33",

(c) in paragraph 1(c), for "£30" substitute "£33",

(d) in paragraph (2), for "£150" substitute "£165", and

(e) in paragraph (3), for "£20" substitute "£22".

2. These Rules may be cited as the Capacity (Lasting Power of Attorney) (Appeals, etc.) (Amendment) Rules, 2023.

3. These Rules shall come into force on 1st January, 2024.
