**The Office of the Lieutenant-Governor of Guernsey  
(Salary and Official Expenses) (Performance of  
Functions) Regulations, 2023**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS and THE POLICY & RESOURCES COMMITTEE, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 3 and 4 of the States (Reform) (Guernsey) Law, 2015<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:-

**Performance of functions under the Law of 1972.**

1. (1) The functions of the Committee for Home Affairs under section 2 of the Office of the Lieutenant-Governor of Guernsey (Salary and Official Expenses) Law, 1972<sup>b</sup> ("the principal Law") may be performed by the States Policy & Resources Committee in the name of the latter committee.

(2) The Committee for Home Affairs must not perform any of those functions.

**Consequential amendments of statutory references to Committee for Home Affairs.**

2. (1) The principal Law is amended as follows.

(2) In section 2 of the principal Law, for each reference to the Committee for Home Affairs, substitute a reference to the States Policy & Resources Committee.

(3) In section 5 of the principal Law, delete the definition of "**the Committee for Home Affairs**".

**Savings and transitional provisions.**

3. Anything done before the commencement of these Regulations, or in the process of being done on that commencement, by or in relation to the Committee for Home Affairs under section 2 of the principal Law is to have effect as if done, or (as the case may be) may be continued, by or in relation to the States Policy & Resources Committee.

**Citation.**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Office of the Lieutenant-Governor of Guernsey (Salary and Official Expenses) (Performance of Functions) Regulations, 2023.

**Commencement.**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.



#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations arrange for the Policy & Resources Committee to perform the functions of the Committee for Home Affairs in relation to recommending and allocating official expenses under section 2 of the Office of the Lieutenant-Governor of Guernsey (Salary and Official Expenses) Law, 1972. The Committee for Home Affairs must not perform any of those functions while this arrangement subsists.

These Regulations come into force on the 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.
