**The Environmental Pollution (Prescribed Operations)
(Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024**

Made *2nd January, 2024*

Coming into operation *1st February, 2024*

Laid before the States *, 2024*

**THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND POLLUTION
REGULATION**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4(2)(c) and
4(3) of the Environmental Pollution (Waste Control and Disposal) Ordinance, 2010^a
and section 72 of the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004^b and all other
powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the 2019 Regulations.

1. The Environmental Pollution (Prescribed Operations) (Fees) Regulations, 2019^c are amended as follows.

2. For the table in Schedule 1, substitute the following table –

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Environmental Pollution (Prescribed Operations) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024.

Commencement.

6. These Regulations shall come into force on 1st February 2024.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make amendments to the Environmental Pollution (Prescribed Operations) (Fees) Regulations, 2019.

Regulation 2 substitutes the table in Schedule 1 which sets out the fee to accompany an application for a licence for a waste transport operation. The new Schedule 1 contains amendments to the categories of application for the waste transport licence fees as it provides for the levying of different fees according to the number of vehicles used in the operation.

Regulation 3 substitutes the table in Schedule 2 which sets out the fee to accompany an application for a licence for waste operations other than waste transport operations. This amendment increases the fees for other waste operations by 10%.

Regulation 4 substitutes the table in Schedule 3 which sets out the annual licence fee for prescribed waste operations other than waste transport operations. This amendment increases the fees for licensed operations by 10%.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st February 2024.
