**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2024**

THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35(1)(a) and (c) of the Air Navigation (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012^a and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations: -

Restriction of flying Over Government House St Peter Port Guernsey.

1. (1) No UAS including drones shall, from 1900 hours (UTC) on 15th July 2024 until 1900 hours (UTC) on 16th July 2024, fly into the airspace having lateral limits of a circle radius of 1.5 nautical miles centred on Government House St Peter Port, Guernsey (N 49 27.0' W 002 32.51') and vertical limits of the surface to 500' or take off from any place in that area except those mentioned in regulation 1(2).

- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to -
- (a) any drone flying with the permission of the Head of Air Navigation Services, Guernsey,
 - (b) any drone flying with the permission of the Guernsey Law enforcement, or

- (c) any drone flying for the purpose of Search and Rescue or for the purpose of saving life.

Interpretation.

4. All times referred to in these Regulations are Universal Time Coordinated (UTC).

Citation and commencement.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2024 and shall come into force on 15th July 2024.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prohibit (subject to the granting of exemptions) all UAS including drones within a 1.5 nautical miles radius and from the surface to 500' of position:

W 002 32.51'

between 1900 hours (UTC) on the 15th July, 2024 and 1900 hours (UTC) on the 16th July, 2024 by reason of an Royal visit. They impose other restrictions on UAS including drones.
