*Note: **DO NOT write anything in this part of the form.** When you have completed this form, you will need to take it to a person authorised to administer oaths or take sworn declarations in the place that you are, and to swear or affirm before that person that the facts stated in this form are true. The Court will generally accept a statement of truth sworn or affirmed:*

(a) anywhere in the Bailiwick, before a notary public or Advocate of the Royal Court of Guernsey of 5 years' standing or more,

(b) in Guernsey, Herm or Jethou, before a Jurat of the Royal Court of Guernsey,

(c) in Alderney, before a Jurat of the Court of Alderney,

(d) in Sark, before the Seneschal,

(e) in a place outside the Bailiwick –

(i) before a person empowered to administer oaths or take sworn declarations in that place, or

(ii) in accordance with the rules in force in that place governing the swearing of statements of truth.

I/we understand that proceedings for contempt of court may be brought against anyone who makes, or causes to be made, a false statement in a document verified by a sworn statement of truth without an honest belief in its truth.

I/we Swear and promise on the faith and truth that I/we owe to God/Affirm that the facts stated in this form are true. This form is my/our affidavit for the purposes of Rule 15 of the Matrimonial Causes Rules, 2024
