**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment)  
Order, 2024**

*2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2024*

*Coming into operation*

*5<sup>th</sup> September, 2024*

**THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989 is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph 2 of Part V of Schedule 1, the following paragraph -

"3. The section of the Route des Coutures that is between Longue Rue and La Grande Rue: this paragraph -

(a) applies only -

(i) to power-driven vehicles (including motorcycles), and

(ii) from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 2:45 p.m. to 3:15 p.m. on days that Saint Martin's Primary School is open to pupils in accordance with the determinations of the Committee for Education, Sport & Culture under section 8 of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970, or in accordance with any similar power under any other enactment, and

(b) does not apply -

(i) to vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency,

(ii) to vehicles travelling to or from premises, other than Saint Martin's Primary School or any premises relating to that school, located on that section of the Route des Coutures, or

(iii) to anything done with the permission of, or at the direction of, a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey or, within the limits of their

jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary of the Island of Guernsey."

**Repeal.**

2. The Traffic Temporary (Route des Coutures) Regulations, 2023<sup>b</sup> are hereby repealed.


**Citation.**

3. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2024.

**Commencement.**

4. This Order shall come into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2024.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, by making permanent the temporary traffic experiment that introduced a prohibition on driving power-driven vehicles on a section of Route des Coutures during specified times on school days, being the times at which pupils typically arrive at or leave St Martin's Primary School, and so as to enhance the safety of pedestrians and cyclists travelling to and from the school.

Between the specified times the prohibition will apply to all power-driven vehicles other than vehicles travelling to or from other premises situated on the relevant section of road, emergency vehicles, or vehicles being driven on that section by drivers who do so with the permission of, or at the direction of, a police officer.
