The Deputy Bailiff having this day placed before the Court a letter dated 5th May 2010 from the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Ireland advising the States of Guernsey that the constitutional requirements for the entry into force of the following agreements have been fulfilled, namely:

An Agreement dated 26th March, 2009 between the States of Guernsey and the Government of Ireland for the exchange of information relating to tax matters.

An Agreement dated 26th March, 2009 between the States of Guernsey and the Government of Ireland for affording relief from double taxation with respect to certain income of individuals and establishing a mutual agreement procedure between the States of Guernsey and the Government of Ireland in connection with the adjustment of profits of associated enterprises.

THE COURT, after the reading of the said letter and after having heard

Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ORDERED:-

1. That the said letter be registered on the records of this Island and
2. That an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said letter, be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Greffier of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.
